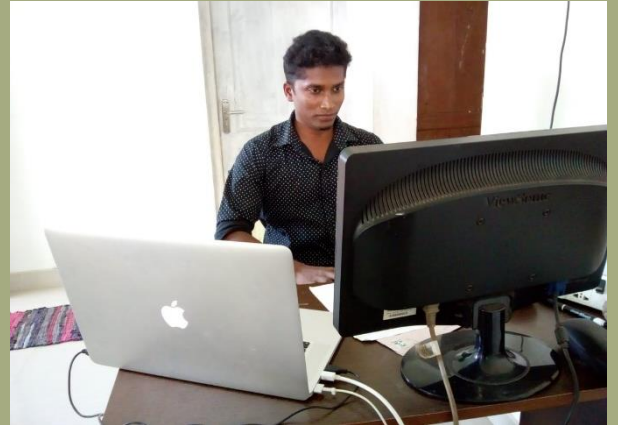

Internal Competitions at CBSE

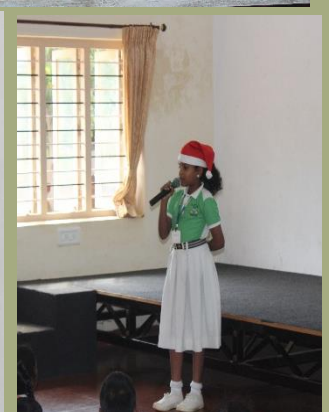
Origami
